WHITE POINT GOLF CLUB LOCAL RULES

1. R.C.G.A. Rules govern all play.
2. Out of bounds marked by white stakes.
3. Lateral water hazards marked by red stakes.
4. A ball striking power lines MUST be replayed. A ball striking power poles is in play.
5. The following are considered obstructions: rocks in closely mowed areas (i.e. fairway), ball washers, water pipes outside of hazards, flag pole and garden, protective screen on 12 tee, club buildings, tee signs, well on 6/15, asphalt road, and graveled paths. If any of these items interfere with stance or swing, ball may be dropped within one club length of nearest point of relief. NO penalty.
6. Know and observe the Rules of Etiquette of golf.
7. Let faster players through. Replace all divots & repair all ball marks. Rake traps after use.
