Check-out Time

Check-out time is 11am, with the following exceptions: Tidewatch (307), Water's Edge (411), Ocean Club (602) and White Point Vacation Club Cottages (301-304 & 406-415) have a 10am check-out. If you should require a later departure time, please consult the Front Desk (0). Extensions will be provided whenever possible (guests hate to leave) however, a day rate may apply.

Accommodations

White Point has a collection of experiences available on property, including; Guest Rooms, one, two-, and three-bedroom Cottages, Lakeside Glomes and Oceanfront Treehouses. We also offer two-, three- and four-bedroom Vacation Homes which give you all the space, convenience, and comfort of a private executive home or cottage including a full kitchen, laundry, wood burning or propane fireplace, BBQ and spacious deck. Some Vacation Homes even include a private hot tub!



Gift Shop

We sure do! You'll find it in the Main Lodge just past the Front Desk. Feel free to drop by just to pick up a gift or something special for yourself or your home. We stock a wide selection of items from many artists on the South Shore. All our products are made in Nova Scotia, so you know you are supporting our local economy and taking a genuine piece of Nova Scotia back home with you. You'll find unique-to-White Point items, including *White Point Then & Now, Destination White Point* and *I Spy a Bunny* – three books inspired by White Point. Be sure to explore

ATM Machine

Yes, there is, it is located in the Main Lodge, on the lower level.

Wi-Fi

Complimentary Wi-Fi is available throughout the resort – no password is required. If the weather is not cooperating, signal strength can be affected. Please note, due to volume of users, we ask that you refrain from streaming movies, etc. - we all share the bandwidth! May we suggest you visit our recreation office to sign out a DVD movie or board game, or take a walk on the beach!

Ice Machine

An ice dispenser is located on the lower level of the Main Lodge and one in the small building located between the Boathouse and Lakeside Hall. If you prefer to have ice delivered to your room, contact the Front Desk (0) and Guest Services will deliver.

Firewood

For accommodations equipped with wood burning fireplaces firewood, newspaper, and kindling are provided in the wood box outside your door, or adjacent to your fireplace. If you would like more complimentary firewood, please contact the Front Desk (0). Tips for lighting your fire can be found on the fireplace mantel in your cottage. If you need any assistance, just contact Front Desk (0).



Onsite Laundry

For guest convenience, there is a coin-operated Laundromat located below the Ocean Spa (next to the Main Lodge). Laundry Detergent may be purchased at the Front Desk.

Cots and Cribs

Accessibility

Indeed, when our new Main Lodge was designed in 2012 – it was created to be fully accessible. There is an elevator that connects the three floors. Please see the Front Desk for access. There are also two barrier-free guestrooms and a two-bedroom suite on the Lower Level of the Main Lodge.

We now have available on property, and complimentary to guests for use, two Mobi-Chair Floating Beach wheelchairs and an All-terrain Hippocampe wheelchair. These innovative products are designed with everyone in mind: wheelchair users, people with additional needs or physical challenges and the elderly. The Mobi-Chair can be used on our beach, and into the water, and the All-terrain Hippocampe enables you adapted physical access to get out and enjoy the trails.

We are so happy to be able to offer these for use to our overnight guests, and are available for sign out from our Boathouse and Recreation Office.



For the comfort of our guests and our staff, we ask that you please refrain from using scented products, such as perfumes and colognes, during your stay at White Point.



Pets on Property

Pets are welcome everywhere except within the Main Lodge and in our pet-free accommodations. We ask that you keep your pets on a leash at all times while they are outside of your accommodation, and that you pick up after them (there are 'scoop bag' stations located throughout the property). Want your furry best friend to enjoy some freedom as well? We are excited to be able to offer all guests, our complimentary fenced in dog park, located beside the outdoor playground.

If you have forgotten water or food dishes, we can help you with that just ask at the Front Desk. *And please, please don't let your pets chase our bunnies or Piping Plovers!*

Foreign Money Exchange

We can exchange American cash or travelers' cheques at the current rate less a nominal service fee. Currency exchange may also be done at one of the banks located in nearby Liverpool, during regular business hours.

You'll find a variety of stations from around Nova Scotia too!

Nature Trail

The Tidal Estuary Loop is a 2 km loop starting adjacent to the Ocean Spa Building and continues along the Tidal Estuary, over the footbridge and through the White Point Estates as



it loops back to the Main Lodge. **Explore Sea'Spired** - Sea'spired is our permanent outdoor Sculpture Show featuring 14 sculptures by Nova Scotian Artists, pick up a copy of the Show Guide from the Front Desk and enjoy exploring!

The Boathouse

Head down to the Freshwater Lake and you'll find our Boathouse. Complimentary with your stay - enjoy stand-up paddle boards, rowboats, kayaks, or bicycles. We also have beach toys, lawn games and so much more for you to sign out.

Our Beach

It would be a shame to stay inside when you've got a vast oceanfront playground to explore. White Point is a yearround beachside playground for the whole family. A day at the beach can be whatever you want at White Point. Our shoreline is 'living' - it moves and changes with each season. Every fall as the hurricanes and storms move up from the south, it gently begins removing the sand. By mid-winter - we have very little sand and plenty of smooth granite stones and basalt exposed. In the spring, as the currents shift, our sand returns. You can watch it happen on our BeachCam on NovaScotiaWebcams.com.







Kids' Zone

This colourful area is packed with games, crafts and a television for watching movies. Follow the giggles to the lower level of the Main Lodge. (The Kids' Zone is not always supervised so please keep that in mind!)

Recreation Programs

Movies & Board Games

Little Pointers' Playground

While the entire Resort is a playground, we do have a real 'playground' located near the Boathouse. Watch your little ones play while you sit, relax and enjoy the incredible lake views.

Our Games Room is full of classic, honest-to-goodness fun. Play pool, ping pong, and foosball. No pressure. No programs. Just fun. Located on the lower level of the Main Lodge.



Try your hand at Pickleball, and have a blast! Pickleball is a sport

that combines elements of tennis, badminton, and ping-pong using a paddle and plastic ball with holes.

Swimming, Surfing or Bodyboarding

Try out your sea legs, and ride the waves! Not a surfer? Try riding a wave with a bodyboard! We have an outdoor wading pool during the summer months, and a freshwater lake, or make a splash year-round in our indoor heated pool! Overlooking the ocean, our indoor pool is family friendly with a gentle slope and 'umbrella' that rains. Warm up in our hot tub on the pool deck and sauna just off the deck. Change rooms equipped with showers and lockers (please bring your own lock) make it easy to come and go from the Main Lodge to your





accommodations. If you are coming from the beach, an outdoor shower is located by the outdoor pool. Please note that all swimming areas are unsupervised.

Ocean Spa

Relaxation should always be on your itinerary when you visit White Point. Enjoy a soothing massage or body treatment set to the tune of crashing waves and seabird calls in our Ocean Spa. Local Attractions

Home-grown exploration.

Located in beautiful southwestern Nova Scotia, we're surrounded by so many treasured attractions here at White Point. During your stay, take time to explore some of the region's intriguing sites, including working fishing towns, port cities, and colourful areas that seem lost in another time. Be sure to check the arts, crafts, and artisan shops along the way. You never know what you'll find!

South Shore Guide

Situated midway along the South Shore – coming to or from White Point. Check out Nova Scotia's South Shore on Facebook or Instagram @VisitNovaScotiaSouthShore

To the West: Just down the road (3km/2miles) you'll find the seaside communities of Hunt's Point, Summerville, Port Mouton and Port Joli. Spend some time at Hunt's Point, Summerville Provincial Beach, and Carter's Beach – then hit the walking trails of Port L'Hebert Pocket Wilderness and the spectacular Kejimkujik National Park Seaside.

To the East: Liverpool (10km/6miles) our closest town, is known as the Port of the Privateers, was founded in 1759 and boasts a rich shipbuilding history. This beautiful small town, situated where the Atlantic Ocean meets the Mersey River, is home to a vibrant arts community, heritage sites, and museums. Liverpool pays homage to its proud past with colourful re-enactments and community festivals throughout the year. The Astor Theatre, one of Nova Scotia's most active small theatres, also calls Liverpool home. Other points of interest include, the Queens County Museum & Perkins House, Fort Point Lighthouse Park, Hank Snow Country Music Centre,-Beach Meadows Beach, Privateer Park, Pine Grove Park, and Medway Head Lighthouse.

Concrete Creations

A must-see Narnia-like world tucked behind Cosby's Garden Centre in Brooklyn. Walk a wooded trail while browsing through the incredible concrete sculptures and creations of local garden sculptor Ivan Higgins. These creations will "not only grab your eye but will capture your soul".
